Mission Statement

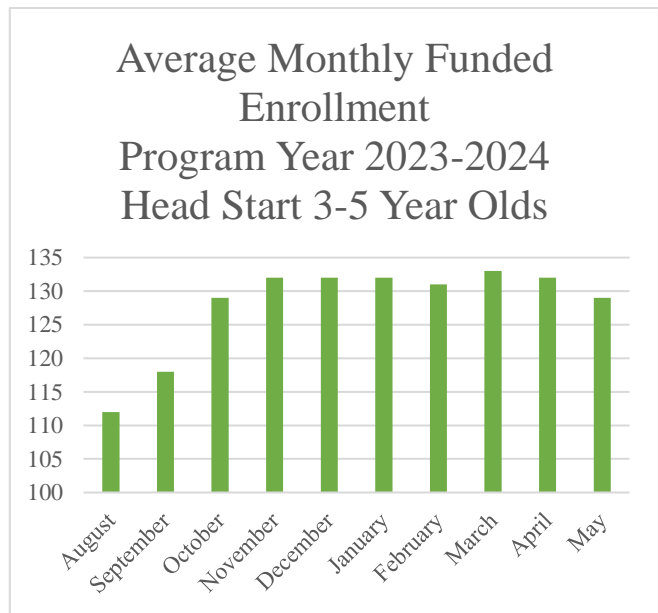

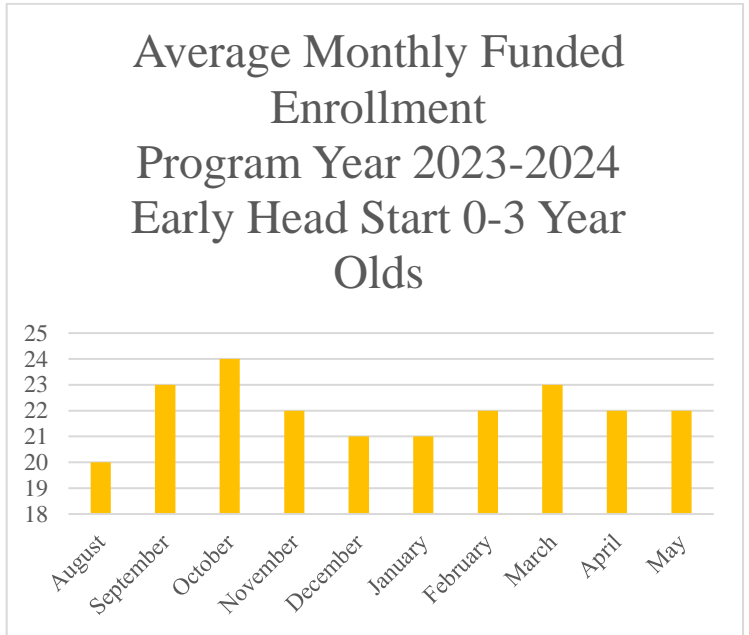

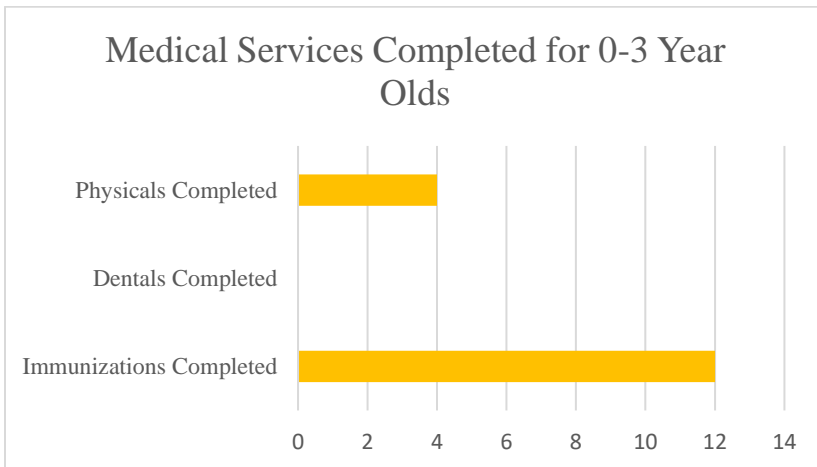
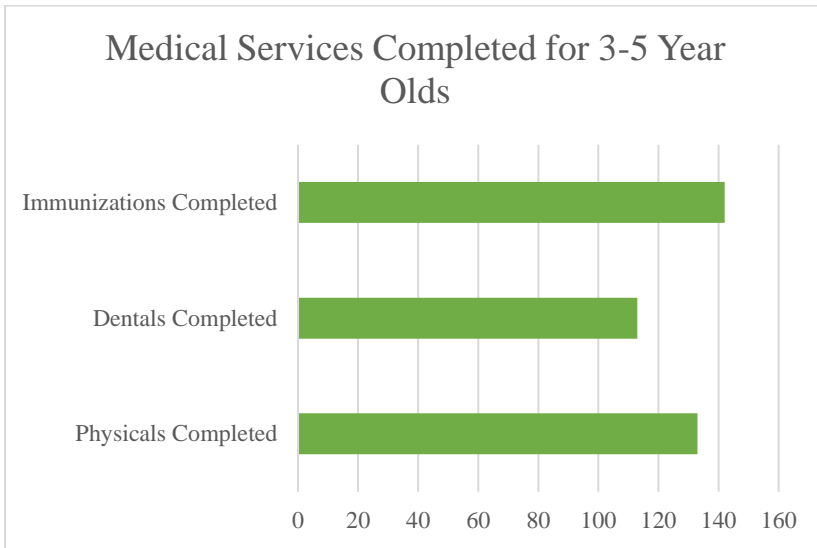
Staff Years of Service

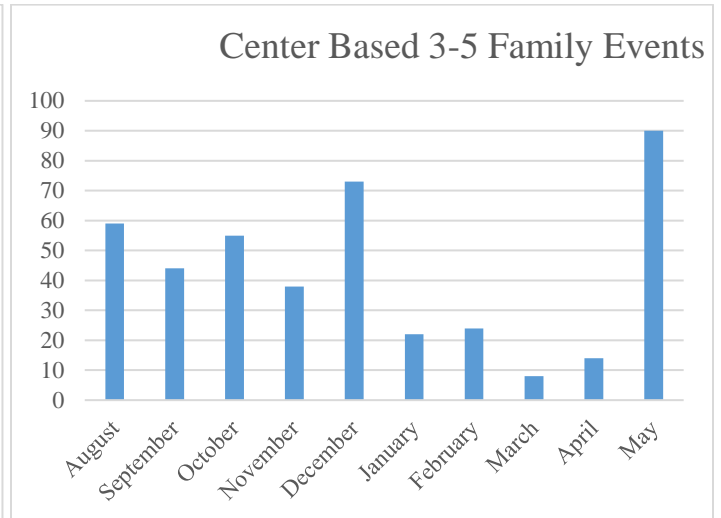
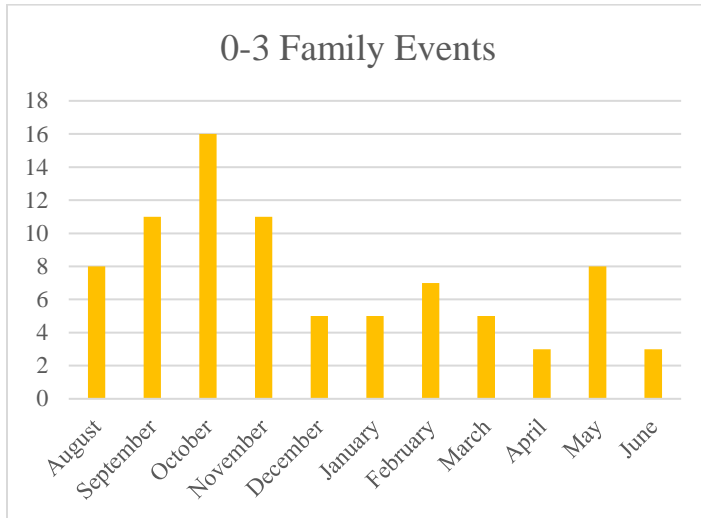
